Directions to Wind Hill Tree Farm (7706 Mellom Road, Arena, WI)

Traveling from Richland Center, east on Hwy 14 toward Arena (Iowa County)

- Turn right on Hwy H
- Go south less than 2.5 miles
- Turn left onto Mellom Road at the quaint church (on the right side)
- Go up..up..up to the top and turn left at the gravel driveway
 - o Look for fire sign 7706 (two fire signs posted here)
- Take left fork to parking area (signed 'Windhill')
 - o DO NOT TAKE RIGHT FORK

Traveling from Madison west on Hwy 14 toward Arena (Iowa County)

- Turn left onto Ray Hollow Road (at edge of Arena; look for <u>blue</u> water tower after this turn)
- Go south and take first right turn (less than 2.5 miles) onto Mellom road
- Go up..up..up to the top and turn right at the gravel driveway
 - o Look for fire sign 7706 (two fire signs posted here)
- Take left fork to parking area (signed 'Windhill')
 - o DO NOT TAKE RIGHT FORK

Can also hit Hwy H near Ridgeway if on Hwy 151; just go north on H to Mellom Road (see church on your left; about 10 miles from Hwy 112) and turn right onto Mellom Road then follow directions above.
