How to find Carlson Tree Farm

30501 County Hwy X; Blue River, WI

From Port Andrews (south)

Take CTH “X” north 3.9 miles
Turn Right on French Lane

From Boaz (north)

Take CTH “E”/Hwy 171 west
0.1 miles Turn Right to follow Hwy 171
2.9 miles Turn Left on CTH “F”
1.2 miles Turn left on CTH “X”
3.0 miles Turn left on French Ln
